

## 4. User Management

The central target of the created alert scenarios is the EVALARM **user**. These are the ones who are responsible for the necessary actions from the information prepared by EVALARM.

Users are divided into passive **employees** and active **users** who are directly involved in the alerting process.


To organize structured alert scenarios, EVALARM uses a **role concept** for users, which regulates the different permission options. This ensures that the right users - and only those - have access to the information and actions.

In addition to the authorization, you can group users into individually adjustable **user groups** to structure targeted alerting.

To fit the work plans to match the EVALARM users' needs, you can also create **on-call groups**. This function allows you to override the volume profiles of phones and alert the members of the standby group in case of an alert.
